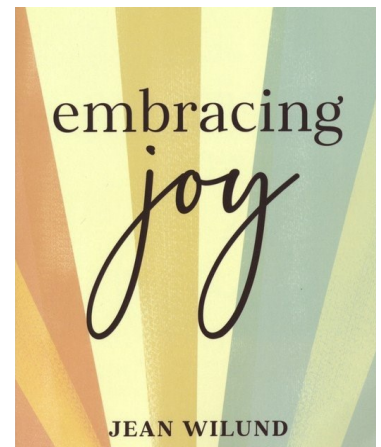
Lydia Circle

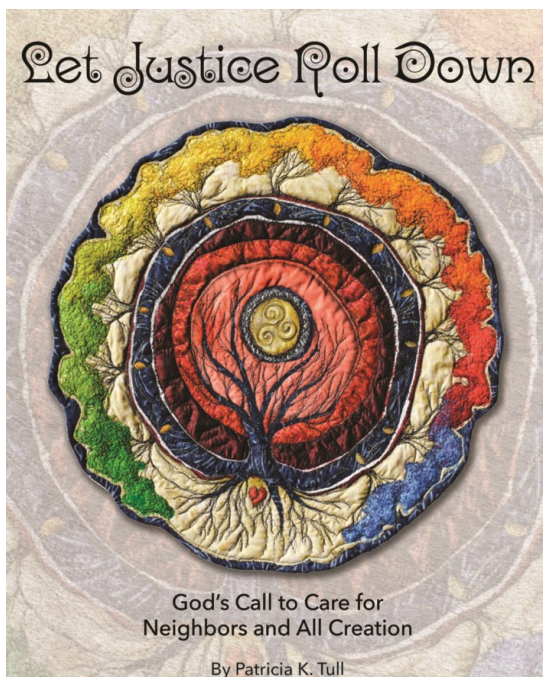
