*(January 15th Stated Meeting)*

- ◆ Elder Paul Pratt opened the meeting with prayer and a devotion from *Jesus Calling* on Jeremiah 29:11
- ◆ The minutes of the November 20 stated meeting were approved.
- ◆ The IRS mileage rate for 2025 is \$0.70.
- ◆ Rev. Mary Sample was appointed to moderate the Annual Congregational Meeting.
- ◆ Elder Commissioner Paul Pratt reported on the December Presbytery Meeting.
- ◆ Facilities Team will install an electric hand dryer in the men's room in Fellowship Hall.
- ◆ The Land Development Subcommittee reported that the area by the lake has been mulched. Future work will be determined.
- ◆ A blanket trespass order has been filed with the Sheriff's department. Requests must be called in by an elder, a member of staff, or a Sunshine Learning teacher.
- ◆ The Nominating Committee reported the slate of candidates for the annual congregational meeting.
- ◆ The Pastor Nominating Committee is reviewing resumes matched by the Church Leadership Connection (CLC) system, and has requested additional information from several potential candidates.
- ◆ Scout Sunday will be observed on February 9th, with members of Cub Pack 285 participating in the worship service. The Session approved the sale of Camp Cards to help fund Pack activities.
- ◆ The February stated session meeting was moved to Wednesday, February 26th at 6:00 p.m. Newly elected officers will be examined at the beginning of the meeting.
- ◆ The meeting was closed with prayer by Moderator Debra Cox.

## Donations for February Cuba Trip



Pat Zinn will visit our partner churches in Iguará and Meneses as part of the February 18th – 25th Presbytery trip to Cuba and is again asking for your help. Her goal is to take 2 suitcases of supplies for each church. The impact of your donations - even simple things like aspirin and vitamins - is far beyond what you might imagine and is truly lifesaving for children and others with fevers. Please place your donations in the blue Cuba bin in the Fellowship Hall.

### The most needed items are:

- ◆ pain relievers (aspirin, ibuprofen, acetaminophen),
- ◆ antihistamine pills and creams (Benadryl, Zyrtec, Meclizine),
- ◆ multivitamins (child and adult - no gummies please!),
- ◆ antacids (bicarb of soda, Alka-Seltzer, Prilosec),
- ◆ anti-diarrheal (Pepto-Bismol, Immodium),
- ◆ skin ointments (triple antibiotic, Clobetasol, Triamcinolone),
- ◆ analgesic creams (Voltaren, Ben-Gay).
- ◆ leftover prescriptions meds, especially antibiotics and high blood pressure meds
